Middle Leadership Development Programme

Staff from St Ursula's Convent School, trained by the National College, now deliver a cross-phase Middle Leadership Development Programme

The programme is open to staff from all Greenwich schools in a Middle Leadership position, for example, Subject or Curriculum Leader, Head of Department, Pastoral Leader, SENCO, Gifted and Talented Co-ordinator and Advanced Skills Teachers.

Course Description: HOW MANY SESSIONS? WHAT WILL THE TIME COMMITMENT BE?

Participants will attend 6 sessions across half day or twilight Inset over a 10 month period. They will be expected to engage in online learning, individual study and action research relevant to their role. Each participant will have a Learning Coach within their own school to support them throughout the programme. Learning Coaches must hold a senior position, attend a half-day training session and commit to at least one hour a month to support the participant.
