Following the announcement made by Gavin Williamson this evening we can confirm that St Ursula's will be opening on:

- Monday 4th January to all daughters of critical key workers and identified vulnerable students.
- Monday 11th January to ALL Year 11 students AND all daughters of critical key workers and identified vulnerable students.
- Monday 18th January to ALL students in ALL year groups.

This means that from Monday 4th January only the daughters of critical key workers and identified vulnerable students are expected to attend school.

We will contact (tomorrow morning via email) the vulnerable students whom we think should attend school from Monday 4th January 2021.
