Dear parents/carers,

I am writing to share with you the return to school plans for September. As you'll be aware, the Government has asked schools to test students on their return to school in September. Greenwich Local Authority is coordinating the provision for Greenwich secondary schools and we will have a testing team on site, just like we did in March.

To accommodate this testing, we will need to have a staggered return to school in September. The plan for each year group is as follows.
