Urban Synergy Ready for Work Conference (Year 10)

On Tuesday 24th May, Urban Synergy, a charity that works with getting students career ready came into school to deliver their Ready for Work conference to our Year 10's, ahead of their final year at St Ursula's.

These programmes utilise individuals from a variety of professions who voluntarily offer young people (mentees) support, guidance and encouragement to achieve their best. The charity believes that high profile role models from all walks of life can make a positive difference to a young person's life and in a relatively short amount of time, Urban Synergy has become a dynamic force for positive change.



The day consisted of 5 sessions including; goal setting, presentation skills, CV writing and mock interviews. Students had to prepare a CV for a job interview for a role at John Lewis. Throughout the day, they learned how to prepare and conduct themselves professionally which was then followed by the mock interview.

We had over 50 volunteers from the City of London who were prepared to interview our students and give feedback. Following this, students were given the opportunity to act on their feedback and re-interview with a different volunteer.



Our year 10's excelled and stepped up to the challenge. This was evident from the positive feedback received from the Urban Synergy team along with our St Ursula's staff. All students left feeling motivated and ready to move forward to achieve their future career goals.

Once year 10 move into year 11, they will get the opportunity to enroll for the free Urban Synergy Mentoring Scheme so please stay tuned for more information.

Lastly, this will be an annual event, meaning the current year 9's will have the same opportunity to experience this worthwhile and inspirational Careers intervention next year when in year 10.




End of Year Assessments
